We meet weekly on Thursday mornings from 9:00 to 11:00 am in Room 3 of the Charlotte Center. Residents and visitors are welcome to join us for one of our meetings, to assess the group and how we operate.

This is a forum to explore and develop writing skills. We attempt to write a story or poem each week. Our process is to print copies of our article for each participant, then read it out loud and receive feedback in the form of suggestions and comments from our peers. We attempt to stay within a 500 word (one page) objective. The topics are varied, including childhood memories, life experiences, social or political commentary, family events, fiction and humour. It is a challenging, yet fun experience and all the participants enjoy it immensely.
